- A situational analysis of large-scale food fortification in West Africa
- Strengthening public sector capacity for governance and strategy coordination of large-scale sustainable fortification at national and regional level in 15 OAAS countries.
- Strengthening public-private partnerships through interministerial fortification alliances
- Revitalizing national food fortification alliances
- Strengthen monitoring of oil, salt and flour fortification by providing key players with new equipment and technical skills.

Beeo Biiga project funded by USDA

- Capacity-building for health professionals (ICPs, midwives, ASBCs) on mother and child health issues
- Setting up GASPA (learning and monitoring group for infant and young child feeding practices)
- Community Scoreboard" approach to promote good nutrition practices and community monitoring of indicators.
- Community videos" approach: promotion the adoption of high-impact best practices through demonstration videos, testimonials made by the community for the community
